CareLinkMI Senior Mobile App: Coming Soon!

CareLinkMI is a secure, user-friendly mobile app being developed by PICF, Inc. to support seniors and caregivers. The app is being built in phases to ensure functionality, accessibility, and compliance (HIPAA, ADA, cybersecurity).



Phase I: Community Resource Hub (Fall 2025)

Easily search and connect to vetted community resources. Seniors and caregivers can use keyword searches or browse categories to find services such as transportation, food, health, home repair, and more.

Phase II: Events Calendar (Spring 2026)

Stay informed on community events submitted by sponsoring organizations. Events will be vetted and, once approved, displayed in the calendar for seniors and caregivers to view and register.

Phase III: Peer Chat (Summer 2026)

Engage and stay connected with other registered CareLinkMI users through a secure peer-to-peer chat feature designed to reduce isolation and support social connection.

Vendor & Partner Enrollment (Open Enrollment)

Community partners and service providers who want to be featured in CareLinkMI must complete the official Vendor Application Form and be vetted by PICF, Inc. Early participating vendors ("pioneers") will be featured at no cost during the launch phase.
